## School uniform.

Most schools in England require children to wear a school uniform.

Boys should wear

- Long grey or black trousers (shorts may be worn in summer)
- White Shirt
- School tie (optional in most primary schools)
- Jumper or sweater with the school logo on. The colour is the choice of the schools.
- Black shoes

Girls have to wear

- As above.
- Girls may wear skirts
- During the summer term girls often wear summer school dresses.

*Read the text about education in Britain. Complete the gaps with the best form of the word in brackets. There may be some words that you don't have to change.*

(In Britain, 1\_\_\_\_\_ (educate) is compulsory between the ages of 5 and 16. At the age of five, children start primary school. Then, at the age of eleven, they begin their secondary education. Most 2\_\_\_\_\_ (child) go to state schools and only 7% 3\_\_\_\_\_ (attend) fee-paying private schools. A school year is divided into three terms. 4\_\_\_\_\_ (near) all schools work a five-day week and they are 5\_\_\_\_\_ (close) on Saturday. The day starts at nine and finishes between three and four. There is a lunch break which usually 6\_\_\_\_\_ (last) about an hour and a quarter. A 7\_\_\_\_\_ (type) timetable includes English, Science, Maths, History, Geography, Art, Music, Physical education and foreign 8\_\_\_\_\_ (language). A lot of schools offer a range of after-school 9\_\_\_\_\_ (active) such as choir, drama and trips to 10\_\_\_\_\_ (interest) places. Young people are expected to show respect for their teachers and obey school rules.

The main exams are GCSE (school-leaving exams at 16), and A-levels (university entrance exams at 18). University students 11\_\_\_\_\_ (graduate) after completing their first degree, usually in three years. Many students then continue 12\_\_\_\_\_ (they) studies for a Master's Degree, or a PhD.
